

Italy - Florence Course Descriptions



Standard Course

Description

Work is in a small group and covers all aspects of the language with a particular emphasis on developing communicative skills in speaking and writing. Each level can be completed in 4 weeks. At the end of each course after successful completion of a test you can progress to the next level.

Lessons 20 lessons per week, 4 lessons per day Monday through Friday. Each lesson lasts 45 minutes.

Duration 2 - 48 weeks

Groups Max. 12 students

Levels There are 10 available levels from absolute beginner to advanced, corresponding to CEF A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 levels.

Starting dates Students having some previous knowledge of Italian may enrol to begin their course on any Monday.

Intensive Course

Description

This course is designed for motivated students who need to improve their Italian language skills either for general use or for their study or work. In the morning you will develop your general Italian language skills. In the afternoon you will develop your listening, speaking and reading skills in the context of media, films, art, history of art and current affairs. You will be given an insight into Italian culture and lifestyle through lectures and practical language activities.

Lessons

30 lessons per week, 4 lessons in the morning and 2 lessons in the afternoon. Monday through Friday. 45 minutes per lesson

2 - 12 weeks

There are 6 available levels from absolute beginner to intermediate corresponding to CEF A1, A2, B1 levels

Students with some previous knowledge of Italian can start on any Monday

Super-Intensive Course

Description

Individual lessons allow you to concentrate on improving specific aspects of the language and on developing the abilities and the vocabulary needed in the professional life.

Lessons 30 lessons per week, 6 lessons per day, of which 4 are in group in the morning and 2 are individual lessons in the afternoon. Each lesson lasts 45 minutes.

Duration 2 - 4 weeks

Groups Max. 12 students

Levels There are 10 available levels from absolute beginner to advanced.

Start dates Students having some previous knowledge of Italian may enrol to begin their course on any Monday.

One-to-One Course

Description

Participants will be working with two or more teachers, each with a special programme suited to the participant's needs. Particularly suited to professionals and executives, this course is tailored to meet the needs of the participants with special requirements in specific language areas.

Lessons 20, 30, 40 lessons per week, from 4 to 8 lessons per day. Each lesson lasts 45 minutes.

Duration 1 - 4 weeks

Levels There are 10 available levels from absolute beginner to advanced.

Art History Course

Description

This course is offered in the afternoon throughout the year, combined with a Standard Course in the morning. The Programme focuses on Florentine Renaissance and foresees visits to museums. The course is held in Italian.

Lessons 6 lessons/week, for a total of 24 lessons. Each lesson lasts 45 minutes.

Duration 2, 3, 4 weeks

Groups Min. 5 participants

Level An elementary level of Italian is required.

Italy - Florence Course Descriptions



Preparatory Course for University Entrance Examination

Description

The course curriculum is tailored to the fields the students plan to study at the University and to the exams they need to take to be admitted to a particular department.

We prepare students for the Entrance Examination in *Architecture, Academy of Fine Arts, Medicine, Veterinary, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Engineering.*

The **10 weeks** long programme includes an in-depth study of the language with focus on study skills, an overview of the main aspects of Italian culture, training on logical skills, emphasis is therefore on the preparation in those subjects required by the departments that apply selective entry. Lessons 240 in total.

The **6 weeks** long programme includes training on logical skills, emphasis is therefore on those subjects required by the departments that apply selective entry. Lessons 160 in total.

The **4 weeks** long programme more intensive for European students. Lessons 100 in total.
