



## General French courses

The General French classes give enough time to study towards one or more goals while working on the four skills:

- Oral comprehension
- Written comprehension
- Oral expression: presentations, debates, role playing working sessions in small groups, spelling, pronunciation ...
- Written expression: introduction to essay, synopsis, press reviews ...

Each class has primary objectives such as developing a competence in:

- Communication
- Grammar: conjugation, syntax, sequence of tenses,
- Semantic
- Modern French: idioms from recent social and cultural events.



## Standard course

Students are continuously encouraged to express themselves orally through guidance (imitation/repetition) or instinctively. Hence, we offer a very friendly environment where students feel confident to interact not only with their fellow students but also with their teachers.

These courses run in the mornings or in the afternoons leaving half days free for self study, social programmes etc.

These courses will help the learner to:

- Improve overall French language skills
- Improve confidence in using French
- Develop an ability to meet and interact with other students from around the world in French.
